# The Opportunity:

Do you have excellent customer service and problem solving skills? Do you enjoy working with the public? If this sounds like you, consider this excellent opportunity with the Toronto Police Service as a District Special Constable. As a key member of your assigned Division, you would be supporting frontline police officers by performing a variety of duties including protection of crime scenes, transporting prisoners, taking witness statements, enforcing parking by-laws, and assisting front desk staff at divisional police stations.

# **Duties & Responsibilities:**

As a District Special Constable you will:

- Transport prisoners to and from detention centres, immigration facilities, medical facilities, hospitals, doctor's offices, police divisions, court houses, arrest locations or other detention locations
- Collect property identified as evidence and ensures it is properly protected, documented, and stored

- Conduct Crime Prevention through Environmental Design (CPTED) audits and meet with community members to provide advice in relation to personal safety when required
- Assist in canvassing for information and searching with respect to evidence or missing persons. Provide information to the community via lectures, pamphlets, displays, etc.
- Take control in emergency situations or at crime scenes until emergency staff or police officers arrive
- Attend and assist in protecting secured crime scenes, under the direction of on scene police constables or supervisors
- Manage prisoners including booking, lodging, feeding, security, safety and movement of persons brought into police custody in accordance with Service procedures
- Maintain the security of prisoners currently in custody and are awaiting treatment at a medical facility, or persons in our care who have been apprehended under the Mental Health Act and are awaiting assessment
- Serve court documents and notices and swears to Affidavits of Service before a Commissioner for Taking Affidavits
- Enforce parking by-laws by issuing parking tags and arranging to have cars towed
- Attend to parking complaints received from the public and take the appropriate action.
- Maintain the security of prisoners in the cell area of the police division and escorts prisoners to and from cells

## **How do I Qualify?**

# **Mandatory Requirements:**

- Grade 12 or approved equivalent combination of education, training and experience. (Note: official transcripts and diplomas will be required. Where education has been completed outside of Ontario, official proof of equivalency must be obtained)
- Minimum of one year of experience working in a customer service environment or with the public.
- Good understanding of the administrative duties arising from an arrest would be considered an asset.
- Good computer skills. Working knowledge of CPIC, Versadex and MNI would be considered an asset.

# **License and Certification Requirements:**

- A valid "G" driver's license (upon submission of application) with no more than six demerit
  points, permitting you to drive an automobile in Ontario with full driving privileges. A good
  driving record is essential
- Current certification in both "Standard First Aid" and "CPR Level C"and AED from an accredited agency by the time an offer of employment is given.
- A current and valid Ontario Association of Chiefs of Police (OACP) Certificate of Results, inclusive of vision and hearing.

(OACP certificates issued prior to January 1, 2020 will still be accepted, as long as all components of the certificate are valid and/or have a valid OACP Certificate of
